
As far as events are concerned, in July 2021, we resumed our monthly picnic/pétanque and our movie nights in January 2022.

About the Artist

Yann Abily

Yann Abily was born in Paris in 1965 and grew up in an artistic family. At 7 years old, he moved to the Loire Valley, heavily influencing his palette, and at 28 years old, he migrated to the USA to live in Louisiana, Indiana, and Florida. He was trained in one of the best French Fine Arts universities in France. He held his first solo exhibition when he was 21 years old, and in 2001 Yann won an important award in the Midwest for his artwork. Now he resides in Florida, working to create robust pieces, and believes that the final visual of the artwork is what is considered the most important aspect of creating art. Lately, colors are leading his work, creating shapes and balance. Growing up in French culture, he transferred his memories to his artwork, ranging from certain recollections to upscale landscapes. His work has been collected in the USA and Europe.
